Dear Parents:

Christian Service Brigade is a program geared to meet the needs of active and adventuresome guys. We meet every Friday evening from 7:00-9:00 p.m. at the Metropolitan Bible Church (MET) on 2176 Prince of Wales Drive from mid-September to mid-May. Each meeting challenges them to grow physically, spiritually, intellectually, and socially as they relate to their peers and to the faithful and committed leaders who work with them. The Goal of Christian Service Brigade for Guys (CSB) is to train and equip guys and young men who will serve God effectively in their home, church, and community. Let me share some information that will help the club run more effectively.

- Each club-level uses a Bible-based Handbook through which the “Guys” achieve awards, badges and some privileges. As a parent, you can play a tremendous part in encouraging and working with your child at home, as well as making sure that they come prepared in order to make this year a successful one.
- Although discipline is not generally a problem, you need to know that if an incident arises, that the leaders will, lovingly but firmly deal with the offenders. Foul language, disobedience to leaders and misconduct may require a discussion with the parents and possibly a one week suspension from club. Your support and understanding in such a situation would be most helpful.
- In order to come prepared your youngster will need to be equipped each week with their uniform, Bible, and handbook. Please NOTE that when winter arrives, a dry pair of non-marking indoor running shoes will be necessary for your child to be able to participate in game time. Boots, socks, or bare feet can be dangerous on the gym floor.
- A yearly calendar of events is attached, but occasionally changes have to be made, we will make every attempt to inform you, or you can check on-line at: http://csb.baldock.ca/csb_calendar.html.
- We will occasionally have an off-site activity, in which case a signed permission form will be required and depending on the activity, a small fee to cover costs.
- There is always a need for workers in any ministry, so if you feel called to help in this way please see me for a workers ministry package.
